FINDINGS AND DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Board of Election Commissioners for the City of Chicago Commissioners Langdon D. Neal, Richard A. Cowen, and Marisel A. Hernandez, organized by law in response to a Call issued by Langdon D. Neal, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of WILLIAM TAYLOR ("Objector") to the nomination papers ("Nominating Papers") of QUEEN WHITLOCK, candidate for the office of Alderman for the 7th Ward, City of Chicago ("Candidate") at the Municipal General Election to be held on February 24, 2015, having convened on December 8, 2014, at 9:00 p.m., in Room 800, 69 West Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois, and having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above-entitled matter, finds that:

1. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.
2. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.

3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.

4. A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on December 8, 2014, and was continued from time to time.


5. The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Officer Martin Greene for further hearings and proceedings.

6. The Objector and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board's Call served upon them to appear before the Hearing Officer on the date and at the time designated in the Hearing Schedule. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objector, WILLIAM TAYLOR, by his attorney, Randy Crumpton; and the Candidate, QUEEN WHITLOCK, pro se.

7. The Board finds that this case is mooted by virtue of the decision rendered by the Electoral Board in related case Rel. ALD-159, wherein the Candidate's Nomination Papers were found to be invalid.


