FINDINGS AND DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Board of Election Commissioners of the City of Chicago Commissioners Langdon D. Neal, Richard A. Cowen, and Marisel A. Hernandez, organized by law in response to a Call issued by Langdon D. Neal, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of WILLIAM TAYLOR ("Objector") to the nomination papers ("Nomination Papers") of FRANCIS PRATT, candidate for the office of Alderman of the 7th Ward of the City of Chicago ("Candidate") to be elected at the Municipal General Election to be held February 24, 2015, having convened on December 8, 2014 at 9:00 a.m., in Room 800, 69 West Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois, and having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above-entitled matter, finds that:

- 1. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.
- 2. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.

- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.
- 4. A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on December 8, 2014 at 9:00 a.m.
- 5. The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Officer Thomas Quinn for further hearings and proceedings.
- 6. The Objector and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board's Call served upon them to appear before the Hearing Officer on the date and at the time designated in the Hearing Schedule. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objector, WILLIAM TAYLOR, by his attorney, Randy Crumpton; and the Candidate, FRANCIS PRATT pro se.
- 7. The Board finds that on December 13, 2014, the Candidate filed papers with the Board of Election Commissioners withdrawing as a candidate for election and requesting that her name not be printed upon the ballot, thus rendering the Objections moot.
- 8. The Electoral Board further finds that another objection filed in related case ALD-154 is also moot based as a result of the Candidate's withdrawal.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the name of FRANCIS PRATT, having withdrawn as a candidate for election to the office of Alderman of the 7th Ward of the City of Chicago, SHALL NOT be printed on the official ballot for the Municipal General Election to be held on February 24, 2015.
