## **FINDINGS AND DECISION**

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Board of Election Commissioners for the City of Chicago Commissioners Marisel A. Hernandez, William J. Kresse and Jonathan T. Swain, organized by law in response to a Call issued by Marisel A. Hernandez, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of Frances M. Sapone ("Objector") to the nomination papers ("Nomination Papers") of Willie E. Stovall, candidate for the office of Republican Party Ward Committeeman for the 29th Ward in the City of Chicago ("Candidate") to be elected at the General Primary Election to be held on March 15, 2016, having convened on December 14, 2015 at 9:00 A.M., in Room 800, 69 West Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois, and having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above-entitled matter, finds that:

- 1. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.
- 2. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.

- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.
- 4. A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on December 14, 2015 and was continued from time to time.
- 5. The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Officer Richard Zulkey for further hearings and proceedings.
- 6. The Objector and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board to appear before the Hearing Officer on the date and at the time designated in the Hearing Schedule. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objector, Frances M. Sapone, by his attorney, Pericles Abbasi; and the Candidate, Willie E. Stovall, pro se.
- 7. The Hearing Officer ordered that an examination of the voter registration records be conducted by clerks and agents under the Board's direction and supervision, in accordance with the laws of Illinois and the rules of the Board.
- 8. The Hearing Officer directed all parties to appear and be present, either personally and/or by their authorized representatives, during this records examination.
- 9. The Candidate and/or his duly authorized representative was present during the examination of the registration records.
- 10. The Objector and/or her duly authorized representative was present during the examination of the registration records.
- 11. The examination of the registration records was completed and the Electoral Board hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the results of the records examination conducted by its clerks and agents. The written report of the result of the registration records

examination is contained in the Electoral Board's file in this case and a copy has been provided or made available to the parties.

- 12. The results of the revised records examination indicate that:
  - A. The minimum number of valid signatures required by law for placement on the ballot for the office in question is 127;
  - B. The number of purportedly valid signatures appearing on the nominating petition filed by the Candidate total 203;
  - C. The number of signatures deemed invalid because of objections sustained as a result of the records examination total 95;
  - D. The remaining number of signatures deemed valid as a result of the records examination total 108.
- 13. The Electoral Board finds that the number of valid signatures appearing on the Candidate's nominating petition following completion of the records examination was less than the minimum number of valid signatures required by law to be placed upon the official ballot as a candidate for election to the office of Republican Party Ward Committeeman for the 29th Ward of the City of Chicago.
- 14. The Hearing Officer conducted a hearing to allow the Candidate an opportunity to present evidence in support of his Rule 8 motion objecting to the Board's clerk's findings during the records examination. As a result of said hearing, the Hearing Officer found that the Candidate's Nomination Papers contained 5 signatures fewer than the require minimum of 127.
- 15. The Hearing Officer has tendered to the Electoral Board a report and recommended decision. Based upon the evidence presented, the Hearing Officer found that the Candidate's Nomination Papers contained only 122 valid signatures, which is less than the

minimum number of valid signatures required by law to be placed upon the official ballot as a candidate for election to the office of Republican Party Ward Committeeman of the 29th Ward of the City of Chicago, and that the Candidate's Nomination Papers should be found invalid.

- 16. The Electoral Board, having considered the evidence and arguments tendered by the parties and the Hearing Officer's report of recommended findings and conclusions of law, hereby adopts the Hearing Officer's recommended findings and conclusions of law. A copy of the Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommended Decision is attached hereto and is incorporated herein as part of the decision of the Electoral Board.
- 17. For the reasons stated above, the Electoral Board finds that the Candidate has an insufficient number of valid signatures on his nominating petitions and that the Nomination Papers of Willie E. Stovall are, therefore, invalid.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Objections of Frances M. Sapone to the Nomination Papers of Willie E. Stovall, candidate for the office of Republican Party Ward Committeeman for the 29th Ward of the City of Chicago, are hereby SUSTAINED and said Nomination Papers are hereby declared INVALID and the name of Willie E. Stovall, candidate for the office of Republican Party Ward Committeeman for the 29th Ward of the City of Chicago, SHALL NOT be printed on the official ballot for the General Primary Election to be

held on March 15, 2016.

## SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This matter was heard, and the following is the summary of the proceedings with the recommendation.

## I. Parties:

Frances M. Sapone, the Objector is represented by Pericles Abbasi.

Willie E. Stovall is represented pro se.

Issues:

The main issue is the number and integrity of signatures on the petitions for candidacy.

With other secondary issues, Objector made an objection to the failure to consecutively number the petition sheets noting a missing page 3. The computer file, the petition copies of the hearing office and the copies given to the Objector all had page 3 missing. A signature exam was ordered.

## III. Record Exam Results-Confusion:

The hearing record exam results were read into the record showing the exam was completed on December 23, 2015 and that the Candidate was 44 signatures fewer than the required minimum. It also showed that 8 pages were filed by the Candidate.

Mr. Stovall objected and presented a copy of a Preliminary Summary Report which showed 3 signatures greater than the required minimum and 14 pages filed.

The original petitions were examined from the Board file. It was discovered that 9 pages were filed and the missing page 3 was among the original petitions in the Board file. Charles Holiday appeared and explained that a mixup occurred with the petitions of candidacy of the Objector in case 16-EB-WC-53. It was correct that Mr. Stovall was 44 signatures below the minimum number. However, now the missing page 3 with 25 signatures is relevant.

It seems Mr. Stovall left the record exam with the erroneous report before the exam was over.

No objections were made to page 3 as it was missing. Also, the objection deadline had past. With Mr. Holiday it was agreed that the final Petition Summary Report was to be corrected as of December 29, 2015 to reflect that the Candidate was 19 signatures below the required minimum. The Candidate got the benefit of the signatures on page 3. This was presented to the Candidate on December 30, 2015.

The Candidate filed a Rule 8 Motion and the Objector did likewise.

Attached to this document are 3 exhibits:

- Exhibit A is the copy of the Final Report dated December 23, 2015 showing 8 pages filed and 44 signatures fewer than required.
- Exhibit B is the copy of the Preliminary Report dated December 21, 2015 showing 14 pages filed and 3 signatures greater than required.
- Exhibit C is the copy of the Final Report dated December 29, 2015 which includes the missing page 3 showing 9 pages filed and 19 signatures fewer than the required minimum.

The record exam will proceed on the basis that the Candidate is 19 signatures less than the required minimum.

## III. Rule 9 Hearing (January 5, 2015):

The Rule 8 Hearing was based on a review of petition signatures, affidavit signatures, Signature Expert Report, and the Final Petition Detail Report. The Hearing Officer sought to apply the test of whether the petition signature was signed by the person purporting to sign it.

Initially, the Objector <u>objected</u> to the style and form of all the affidavits. All affidavits were of the same format.

It was alleged that there was no caption describing the venue wherein the affidavits were to apply.

Next an objection was made as the affidavit related to a specific sheet and line of the petition where the affiant signed. This was memory issue that was beyond the ken of the affiant.

The Objector claimed this process brought about confusion and weakened the credibility of the system.

The objection was denied. The caption was not necessary and no confusion resulted from the omission of captions. Furthermore, sheet and line designations were necessary for the order of the hearing. The purpose was to determine whether the petitions were signed by those whose names appeared on them. The affidavits were notarized and appeared to comply with requirements.

The Rule 8 Hearing commenced. As the Candidate was <u>pro se</u>, he presented affidavits out of sequence. They were marked according to the manner they were presented. They were presented as follows:

The summary is that 21 affidavits were presented. Of these, 6 were stricken leaving 15 valid signatures for the candidate.

Before the end of the hearing, Objector referred to its Rule 8 Motion and noted Sheet 1, Line 2 of the petition sheet. The signature is Travon Hillard at 4830 W. Harrison. Board official records were presented for review and no Travon Hillard was registered at 4830 W. Harrison. There was Jaozell Hillard and not Travon Hillard. This Sheet 1, Line 2 is stricken.

## IV. Summary:

The Candidate was 19 signatures fewer than the required minimum. The addition of Sheet 1, Line 2 made it 20 signatures fewer than the required minimum. Through affidavits, 15 signatures were rehabilitated. The Candidate is left with 5 signatures fewer than the required minimum.

## V. Recommendation:

Because the Candidate is 5 signatures fewer than the required minimum, it must be recommended that this name not appear on the ballot for Ward Committeeman.
