D E C I S I O N

The duly constituted Election Board, consisting of MICHAEL E. LAVELLE, JAMES R. NOLAN and CORNEAL A. DAVIS, organized by law in response to a Call issued by MICHAEL E. LAVELLE, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon Objections to Nominating Petitions of the Jesse Aguilar Independent Party Party for the office of Representative in the General Assembly Representative District; having convened on August 15, 1986, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 1707, Richard J. Daley Center, Chicago, Cook County, Illinois; and having heard and determined the objections to the petitions in the above entitled matter, finds that:

1. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois;
2. Objections to the nominating petition of the new political party candidate(s) herein were duly filed;
3. A Call to the hearing on said objections was duly issued and was served upon the members of the Electoral Board the objector and the New Political Party candidate by mail and by personal service as provided by statute;
4. A public hearing was held on these objection commencing on August 15, 1986;
5. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearings: the members of the Electoral Board; the objector, ~~pro se (or) by counsel~~; and the candidate, ~~pro se (or) by counsel~~;

6. ~~Objections having been withdrawn (or)~~

~~The candidate agreeing that his name not be printed on the ballot to avoid a hearing on the objections (or)~~

The Board denies the candidate's motion to dismiss the objector's petition. The Board, having reviewed the entire record and the report of the hearing examiner, hereby finds the candidate's statement of candidacy to be invalid as the candidate is not qualified for the office sought for failure to meet the two-year residency requirement as mandated by Article IV Section 2 c of the Illinois Constitution.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the objections of _____

Maria Gutierrez to said New Political Party nominating petition are hereby sustained ~~(or) overruled~~; and the said nominating petition is hereby declared ~~valid (or)~~ invalid and the name of Jesse Aguilar, candidate for the office of Representative in the General Assembly, Representative District, for the Jesse Aguilar Independent Party ~~Political Party shall not~~ shall not be printed on the ballot for the General Election held on November 4, 1986.
