6. The Board finds that the Candidate has withdrawn his nomination papers.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the name of Robert N. Oberg, candidate for nomination to the office of State Senator of the 6th Legislative District, Republican Party, shall not be printed on the ballot for the Primary Elections to be held on March 17th, 1992.
