FINDINGS AND DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Chicago Board of Election Commissioners Langdon D. Neal, Richard A. Cowen, and Marisel A. Hernandez, organized by law in response to a Call issued by Langdon D. Neal, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of YVETTE WILLIAMS and VIRGIL E. JONES ("Objectors") to the nomination papers ("Nomination Papers") of LAWRENCE A. 'ANTON' SEALS, JR., candidate for nomination of the Democratic Party to the office of Representative in the General Assembly for the 32nd District, State of Illinois ("Candidate"), having convened on November 20, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at 69 W. Washington Street, 8th Floor Conference Room, Chicago, Illinois, and having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above-entitled matter, finds that:

1. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.

2. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.

3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objectors and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.

4. A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on November 20, 2007 and was continued from time to time.

5. The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Examiner Edwin Reyes for further hearings and proceedings.


6. The Objectors and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board to appear before the Hearing Examiner for a hearing on the date and at the time designated on the Electoral Board's docket. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objectors, YVETTE WILLIAMS and VIRGIL E. JONES, appearing pro se; and the Candidate, LAWRENCE A. 'ANTON' SEALS, JR., appearing by counsel, Michael J. Kasper.

7. The Electoral Board finds that on November 26, 2007, the Candidate filed papers with the Illinois State Board of Elections withdrawing as a candidate and requesting that his name not be printed on the ballot, thus rendering the Objections moot.



Illinois, SHALL NOT be printed on the official ballot for the General Primary Election to be held on February 5, 2008.



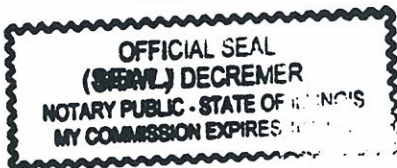


FINDINGS AND DECISIONS

The Captioned matter was scheduled for the initial hearing on Tuesday, November 20, 2007 at 2:30 p.m., on the lower level at 69 W. Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois.

The objections raised by the Petitioner-Objector were; 1.) The two year residency requirement for the office sought , and, 2.) That the Statement of the Candidacy. And the petitions could not be read together.

The Respondent-Candidate Lawrence A "Anten" Seals, Jr. requested time to respond to the allegations of Petitioner-Objector Yvette Williams and Virgil Jones.

The matter was continued to Tuesday, November 27, 2007 at 12:00 p.m.

On November 26, 2007, the Respondent-Candidate Lawrence A. "Anten" Seals, Jr. filed with

the Chicago Board of Elections a "Withdrawal of Candidacy." pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/7/2.10-7. (See Exhibit A, Attached).

The Hearing Examiner, Edwin Reyes recommends that Respondent-Candidate Lawrence A. "Anten" Seals, Jr. name not appear on the ballot for the February 5, 2008 General Primary Election due to his filing withdrawal of candidacy.

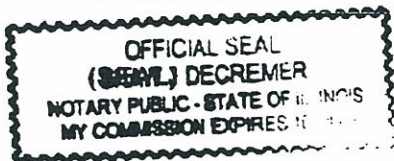

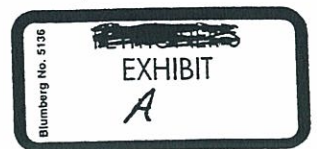
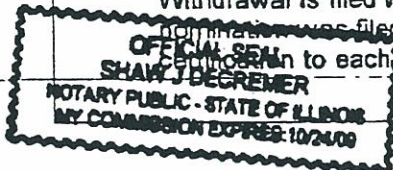
