FINDINGS AND DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Chicago Board of Election Commissioners Langdon D. Neal, Richard A. Cowen, and Marisel A. Hernandez, organized by law in response to a Call issued by Langdon D. Neal, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of MARYBETH WELSH and MARIA CARMEN ABREGO ("Objectors") to the nomination papers ("Nomination Papers") of JESSICA J. JARAMILLO, candidate for nomination of the Democratic Party to the office of State Senator for the 20th Legislative District, State of Illinois ("Candidate"), having convened on November 20, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at 69 W. Washington Street, 8th Floor Conference Room, Chicago, Illinois; and having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above-entitled matter finds that:

1. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.

- The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.
- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objectors and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.
- A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on November 20,
 2007 and was continued from time to time.
- The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Examiner William P.
 Jones for further hearings and proceedings.
- 6. The Objectors and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board to appear before the Hearing Examiner for a hearing on the date and at the time designated on the Electoral Board's docket. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objectors, MARYBETH WELSH and MARIA CARMEN ABREGO; appearing by counsel, Michael C. Dorf; and the Candidate, JESSICA J. JARAMILLO appearing *pro se*.
- 7. The Electoral Board finds that on November 29, 2007, the Candidate filed papers with the Illinois State Board of Elections withdrawing as a candidate and requesting that her name not be printed upon the ballot, thus rendering the Objections moot.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the name of JESSICA J. JARAMILLO, candidate for the nomination of the Democratic Party to the office of State Senator for the

20th Legislative District, State of Illinois, SHALL NOT be printed on the official ballot for the General Primary Election to be held on February 5, 2008.
