FINDINGS AND DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Chicago Board of Election Commissioners Langdon D. Neal, Richard A. Cowen, and Marisel A. Hernandez, organized by law in response to a Call issued by Langdon D. Neal, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of LARRY G. NELSON ("Objector") to the nomination papers ("Nomination Papers") of ROGER WASHINGTON, candidate for the office of Ward Committeeman for the 24th Ward of the City of Chicago, Democratic Party ("Candidate"), having convened on November 26, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at 69 W. Washington Street, 8th Floor Conference Room, Chicago, Illinois, and having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above-entitled matter, finds that:

- Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.
- 2. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.

- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.
- A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on November 26,
 2007 and was continued from time to time.
- The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Examiner William J.
 Cadigan for further hearings and proceedings.
- 6. The Objector and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board to appear before the Hearing Examiner for a hearing on the date and at the time designated on the Electoral Board's docket. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objector, LARRY G. NELSON, appearing pro se; and the Candidate, ROGER WASHINGTON appearing pro se.
- 7. The Objector alleged, among other things, that none of the Candidate's nominating petition sheets were numbered.
- 8. The Hearing Examiner examined the Candidate's nominating petition sheets and found that none of the 53 petition sheets filed by the Candidate were numbered.
- 9. The Hearing Examiner has tendered to the Electoral Board his report and recommended decision. The Hearing Examiner recommends that the Objections to the Candidate's Nomination Papers be sustained and that the Nomination Papers be found invalid.

- 10. Section 7-10 of The Election Code (10 ILCS 5/7-10) requires that petition sheets, before being presented to the electoral board or filed with the proper officer shall be neatly fastened together in book form and the sheets shall then be numbered consecutively.
- 11. The Board finds that none of the petition sheets filed by the Candidate as part of his Nomination Papers are numbered and they are not numbered consecutively as required by Section 10-4 of The Election Code.
- 12. The Electoral Board, having reviewed the record of proceedings in this matter and having considered the report and recommendations of the Hearing Examiner, as well as all argument and evidence submitted by the parties, hereby adopts the Hearing Examiner's recommended findings and conclusions of law.
- 13. The Electoral Board finds that the Candidate's failure to number any of the pages of his nominating petition invalidates his Nomination Papers. *Wollan v. Jacoby*, 274 Ill.App.3d 388, 653 N.E.2d 1303 (First Dist. 1995). While substantial compliance with a mandatory requirement may sometimes be enough (see *King v. The Justice Party*, 284 Ill.App.3d 886, 672 N.E.2d. 900, (First Dist 1996)), here there was no compliance at all.
- 14. For the reasons stated above, the Electoral Board sustains the Objections to the Candidate's Nomination Papers and finds that the Candidate's Nomination Papers are invalid.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the Objections of LARRY G. NELSON to the Nomination papers of ROGER WASHINGTON, candidate for the election to the office of Ward Committeeman for the 24th Ward of the City of Chicago, Democratic Party, are hereby SUSTAINED and said Nomination Papers are hereby declared INVALID and the name of ROGER WASHINGTON, candidate for election to the office of Ward Committeeman for the 24th Ward of the City of Chicago, Democratic Party, SHALL NOT be printed on the official ballot for the General Primary Election to be held on February 5, 2008.
