FINDINGS AND DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Chicago Board of Election Commissioners Langdon D. Neal, Richard A. Cowen, and Marisel A. Hernandez, organized by law in response to a Call issued by Langdon D. Neal, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of CHRISTOPHER B. RANDELL ("Objector") to the nomination papers ("Nomination Papers") of WAYNE THORP, candidate for election to the office of Ward Committeeman for the 47th Ward of the City of Chicago, Republican Party ("Candidate"), having convened on November 26, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at 69 W. Washington Street, 8th Floor Conference Room, Chicago, Illinois, and having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above-entitled matter, finds that:

 Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.

- 2. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.
- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.
- A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on November 26,
 2007 and was continued from time to time.
- The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Examiner Richard E.
 Zulkey for further hearings and proceedings.
- 6. The Objector and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board to appear before the Hearing Examiner for a hearing on the date and at the time designated on the Electoral Board's docket. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objector, CHRISTOPHER B. RANDELL, appearing by counsel, Thomas Jaconetty; and the Candidate, WAYNE THORP, appearing by counsel, Timothy Sprague.
- 7. The Hearing Examiner ordered that an examination of the registration records be conducted by clerks and agents under the Board's direction and supervision, in accordance with the laws of Illinois and the rules of the Board.
- 8. The Hearing Examiner directed all parties to appear and be present, either personally and/or by their authorized representatives during the records examination.
- 9. The Candidate and his duly authorized representative(s) were present during the examination of the registration records.

- 10. The Objector and his duly authorized representative(s) were present during the examination of the registration records.
- 11. The examination of the registration records was completed and the Electoral Board hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the results of the records examination conducted by its clerks and agents. The written report of the results of the registration records examination is contained in the Electoral Board's file in this case and is available for inspection upon request of a party.
- 12. The Electoral Board has considered all evidence and arguments tendered by the parties.
 - 13. The Electoral Board finds that:
 - A. The minimum number of valid signatures required by law for placement on the ballot for the office in question is 24;
 - B. The number of purportedly valid signatures appearing on the nominating petition filed by the Candidate total 45;
 - C. The number of signatures deemed invalid because of objections sustained total 17;
 - D. The remaining number of signatures deemed valid total 28.
- 14. The Electoral Board finds that the number of valid signatures appearing on the Candidate's nominating petition following completion of the records examination exceeds the minimum number of valid signatures required by law to be placed upon the official ballot as a candidate for election to the office of Ward Committeeman for the 47th Ward of the City of Chicago, Republican Party.

- 15. The Electoral Board finds, therefore, that the Objector's Petition are sustained in part and overruled in part as more fully indicated in the results of the records examination.
- 16. The Electoral Board further finds that there are additional and pending objections filed against the Candidate's Nomination Papers in case number 08-EB-WC-45, which objections will determine whether the Nomination Papers of WAYNE THORP are valid.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Objections of CHRISTOPHER B.

RANDELL to the Nomination Papers of WAYNE THORP, candidate for election to the office of Ward Committeeman for the 47th Ward of the City of Chicago, Republican Party, are hereby OVERRULED.
