FINDINGS AND DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Chicago Board of Election
Commissioners Langdon D. Neal, Richard A. Cowen, and Marisel A. Hernandez,
organized by law in response to a Call issued by Langdon D. Neal, Chairman of said
Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of
Yvette Williams and Virgil E. Jones ("Objectors") to the nomination papers
("Nomination Papers") of Syron M. Smith, candidate for nomination of the Democratic
Party for the office of Representative in the General Assembly, 32nd Representative
District, State of Illinois ("Candidate"), having convened on November 16, 2009, at 10:00
a.m., at 69 W. Washington Street, 8th Floor Conference Room, Chicago, Illinois, and
having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the aboveentitled matter, finds that:

1. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.

- 2. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.
- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objectors and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.
- A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on November 16,
 2009 and was continued from time to time.
- The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Officer Casandra B.
 Watson for further hearings and proceedings.
- 6. The Objectors and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board to appear before the Hearing Officer for a hearing on the date and at the time designated on the Electoral Board's Initial Hearing Schedule. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objectors, Yvette Williams and Virgil E. Jones, appearing pro se; and the Candidate, Syron M. Smith, appearing pro se.
- 7. The Electoral Board finds that on November 25, 2009 the Objectors moved to withdraw their Objections against the Candidate's Nomination Papers. The Electoral Board grants the Objectors' motions to withdraw the Objections and the Objections are withdrawn.
- 8. The Electoral Board further finds that there are other objections filed against the Candidate's Nomination Papers in cases 10-EB-RGA-21 and 10-EB-RGA-22. The Candidate withdrew as a candidate, rendering those objections moot.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Objections of YVETTE WILLIAMS

and VIRGIL JONES are withdrawn and this case is dismissed as moot.
