FINDINGS AND DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of Chicago Board of Election
Commissioners Langdon D. Neal, Richard A. Cowen, and Marisel A. Hernandez,
organized by law in response to a Call issued by Langdon D. Neal, Chairman of said
Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon objections ("Objections") of
Yolanda Mondragon and Adolfo Mondragon ("Objectors") to the nomination papers
("Nomination Papers") of Antonio "Tony" Munoz, candidate for nomination of the
Democratic Party for the office of State Senator, 1st Legislative District, State of Illinois
("Candidate"), having convened on November 16, 2009, at 10:00 a.m., at 69 W.
Washington Street, 8th Floor Conference Room, Chicago, Illinois, and having heard and
determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above-entitled matter, finds
that:

1. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly and timely filed.

- The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.
- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued by the Chairman of the Electoral Board and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objectors and the Candidate, by registered or certified mail and by Sheriff's service, as provided by statute.
- 4. A public hearing held on these Objections commenced on November 16,2009 and was continued from time to time.
- The Electoral Board assigned this matter to Hearing Officer Terence E.
 Flynn for further hearings and proceedings.
- 6. The Objectors and the Candidate were directed by the Electoral Board to appear before the Hearing Officer for a hearing on the date and at the time designated on the Electoral Board's Initial Hearing Schedule. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the Objectors, Yolanda Mondragon and Adolfo Mondragon, appearing by counsel, Nicholas C. Kefalos; and the Candidate, Antonio "Tony" Munoz, appearing by counsel, Michael J. Kasper.
- 7. The Objectors moved to substitute the Hearing Officer, Mr. Flynn.

 Pursuant to motion, the case was re-assigned to Rodney W. Stewart.
- 8. The Electoral Board finds that on December 1, 2009 the Objectors moved to withdraw their Objections against the Candidate's Nomination Papers. The Electoral Board grants the Objector's motion to withdraw the Objections and the Objections are withdrawn.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Objections of YOLANDA

MONDRAGON and ADOLFO MONDRAGON in case 10-EB-SS-01 are withdrawn and this case is dismissed as moot and there being no other objections to the Nomination Papers of ANTONIO "TONY" MUNOZ, candidate for nomination of the Democratic Party for the office of State Senator, 1st Legislative District, State of Illinois, such Nomination Papers are deemed VALID and the name of ANTONIO "TONY" MUNOZ, candidate for nomination of the Democratic Party for the office of State Senator, 1st Legislative District, State of Illinois, SHALL be printed on the official ballot for the General Primary Ballot to be held on February 2, 2010.
