





3. A call to the hearing on said objections was duly issued and was served upon the members of the Municipal Officers Electoral Board, the Objector and the Candidate by mail and by personal service as provided by statute;
4. A public hearing was held on these objections commencing on December 30, 1988;
5. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearings: the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector, pro se, and the Candidate by counsel;
6. The Board further finds that the objections are overruled and the candidate's motion to strike is granted. Specifically, the Board finds that the objection "not in proper person as in official election binder" fails to meet the statutory standard of Sec. 10-8 of the Election Code that the objector "state fully the nature of the objections."

Further, the Board finds that the objected-to sheets in fact set forth the dates of circulation and are properly notarized.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the name of Kenneth R. Hurst, as candidate for nomination to the office of Mayor of the City of Chicago, Republican Party, shall be printed on the Republican ballot for the Special Mayoral Primary Election to be held on February 28, 1989.
