## **DECISION**

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of MICHAEL J. HAMBLET, ARNETTE R. HUBBARD, and RICHARD A. COWEN, organized by law in response to a Call issued by MICHAEL J. HAMBLET, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon Objections to Nomination Papers of Candidates for the Offices of Mayor, City Clerk, City Treasurer and Alderman for the City of Chicago, having convened on January 3 1995, at 1:00 p.m., in having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above entitled matter find that:

- 1. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois;
- 2. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly filed;
- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector and the Candidate, by mail and by personal service, as provided by statute;
- A public hearing was held on these Objections commencing on January 3, 1995;
- 5. The following persons, among others, were present at such

- hearing: the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector and his personal representative, and the Candidate by counsel;
- 6. The Board finds that Section 10-8 of the Election Code requires that the objector's petition shall (a) give the objector's name and residence address; (b) state fully the nature of the objections to the certificate of nomination or nomination papers; (c) state the interest of the objector; and (d) state what relief is requested of the electoral board.
- 7. Objections which fail to fully state the nature of the objection shall be overruled. <u>Cleveland v. Sohn</u>, 88 EB-SMAY-11, <u>Cleveland V. Holowinski</u>, 88-EB-SMAY-15, <u>Cleveland v. Hurst</u>, 88 EB-SMAY-18.
- 8. The Board finds that paragraphs 5 through 10 and paragraph 13 of the Objector's Petition refer to and incorporate by reference an "Appendix-Recapitulation attached hereto and incorporated herein" when, in fact, such a document is not attached to the Objector's Petition. The Board finds that said Objections fail to fully state the nature of the objections and they are, therefore, dismissed.
- 9. The Board finds that the Candidate's Statement of Candidacy fails to state to identify the political party to which the Candidate's Nomination Papers relate as provided by Section 7-10 of the Election Code. The Board further finds that the Candidate's nominating petition sheets do not contain at the top of each sheet above the space for signatures a heading which gives information as to the political party represented as required by Section 7-10.
- 10. The Board finds that the Candidate has not substantially complied with the provisions of Section 7-10 of the Election Code in that the Candidate's Nomination Papers, when read together and in their entirety, do not clearly state the political party to which the Nomination Papers relate and the Nomination Papers are so lacking in essential detail that there is confusion as to the political party to which the Nomination Papers relate. Therefore, the Board sustains paragraphs 11 and 12 of Objector's Petition.
- 12. The Board finds, therefore, that the Objector's Petition is sustained in part and that the Candidate's Nomination Papers are invalid.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the Objections of Shariar Fouladi to the Nomination Papers of Themis Anagnost, Candidate for the nomination of the Republican Party for the office of Mayor, City of Chicago, are hereby SUSTAINED and said Nomination Papers are hereby declared INVALID and the name of Themis Anagnost, Candidate for the nomination of the Republican Party for the office

of Mayor, City of Chicago, shall NOT be printed on the ballot for the Municipal Primary Election for the Republican Party to be held on February 28, 1995.
