DECISION

The duly constituted Electoral Board, consisting of MICHAEL J. HAMBLET, ARNETTE R. HUBBARD, and RICHARD A. COWEN, organized by law in response to a Call issued by MICHAEL J. HAMBLET, Chairman of said Electoral Board, for the purpose of hearing and passing upon Objections to Nomination Papers of Candidates for the Offices of Mayor, City Clerk, City Treasurer and Alderman for the City of Chicago, having convened on January 3 1995, at 1:00 p.m., in having heard and determined the Objections to the Nomination Papers in the above entitled matter find that:

- 1. The said Electoral Board has been legally constituted according to the laws of the State of Illinois;
- 2. Objections to the Nomination Papers of the Candidate herein were duly filed;

- 3. A Call to the hearing on said Objections was duly issued and served upon the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector and the Candidate, by mail and by personal service, as provided by statute;
- 4. A public hearing was held on these Objections commencing on January 3, 1995;
- 5. The following persons, among others, were present at such hearing: the members of the Electoral Board, the Objector by his representative, and the Candidate pro se;
- 6. The Board finds that the Candidate failed to file a statement of candidacy and failed to file a receipt showing that he filed a Statement of Economic Interest in relation to his candidacy with the appropriate officer, both of which are required by Section 10-5 of the election code.
- 7. Therefore, the Board sustains the objections to the Candidate's nomination papers and declares the Candidate's nomination papers to be invalid.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the Objections of Charles Mobley to the Nomination Papers of Leon Beard, Candidate for the nomination of the Republican Party for the office of Mayor, City of Chicago, are hereby sustained and said Nomination Papers are hereby declared invalid and the name of Leon Beard, Candidate for the nomination of the Republican Party for the office of Mayor, City of

Chicago, shall not be printed on the ballot for the Municipal Primary Election for the Republican Party to be held on February 28, 1995.
